## Mostlandian Championship Competition Details

**Saturday, August 4, 2007**

**7PM - 12 AM as follows:**

**7 PM Navigation** - Places will be awarded in order of arrival. Ties for contestants arriving at the same time will be broken by giving the contestant who has traveled the greater distance the higher placement.

**Cigarette Rolling** - Contestants must provide all cigarette rolling materials, including the smoking material. Cigarette rolling machines are not permitted.

**11 PM Xeroxing** - \$2 Entry fee. Contestants must arrive at proper location (1605 NE 7th). Fee provides competitors with a pre-paid copy card and a small stack of papers.

**Sunday, August 5, 2007**

**1-6 PM in the following order:**

**Coffee Making** - Contestants must provide all coffee making materials, including but not limited to: coffee beans or grounds, grinders, filters, percolators, French presses, and mugs. The M.O.S.T. will provide water, half and half, sugar, and electrical outlets. Contestants will declare which of four categories they are entering into: Drip, French Press, Percolator, and Camping Coffee. The coffee produced by the contestants will be judged by a panel of judges, based on criteria such as taste, aroma, awakability, and coolest coffee mug.

**CPR** - Guest referee: Citizen Chelsea Cain. Pen and paper provided. Contestants are allowed to bring and use writing surfaces and typewriters. Laptops are not permitted.

**Bowhunting** - Contestants are encouraged to assemble their own four-member team, but referees will attempt to muster members from the audience

**Computer Hacking** - Guest referee: Citizen Michael Merrill. Major points if you know how to count using the binary system.

**Fencing** - Wood and nails provided. Contestants must provide their own tools.

**Slam Dunk!** - Ball provided. Sports attire required.

**Roller Skating** - Contestants must provide their own roller skates music and "hot pants." The MOST will provide a CD player.

**Ongoing Skills Tests:**

Contestants may compete in the following skills at any point during the Championships.

**Double Dutch and Pig Latin** - Can you speak it? For how long?  
**Tongue to Nose** -Judged on range of motion, shape and endurance  
**Cartography** - Test your map-making skills.  
**Joke Telling** - Timing is everything!
